Come out at during any part of the month to participate and shoot the event as many times as you want. At the end of the month we will give away prizes for the top shooters in the event. Here's how it works:

- Event Cost \$5 per target (buy as many targets as you want)
- 5 Shots per target at 15 yards
- No time limit
- Target is FBI-IP1, will be scored using Pure and Cut scoring system. Total out of 50 Points.
- Pistol Caliber must be 380 and up. (No .22)

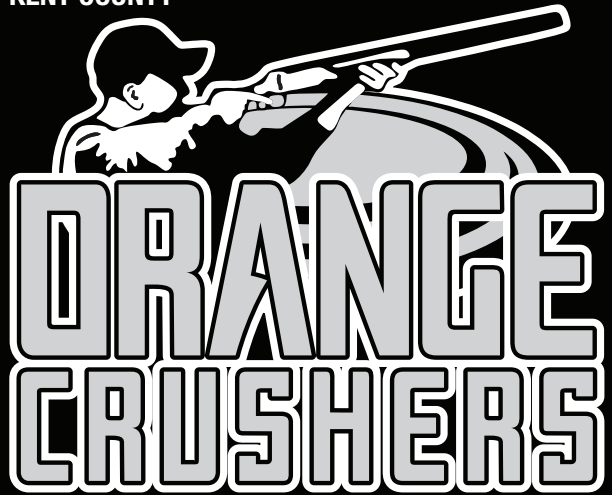
