This year we are doing a "Winter League" kick off weekend. December 5th and 6th we will be starting the sign ups. When you sign up this weekend you will be receiving a 4 punch shooting card and 1 extra ticket for the gun that we are giving away to one lucky winner. Also, that weekend we will be having free lunch both days as well as having some fun raffles, and we will be giving 1 case of shells away both days.

This year we will changing things a bit. We have had some suggestions to go back to the old way of keeping track on shooting ahead or behind.
