SCTP Kids – Nationals Results

We took 24 kids to Cardinal Shooting Center for a week of practice and shooting Skeet and Sporting Clays Competition. There were over 2200 kids from 34 different states shooting skeet, sporting clays, and trap. We shot 200 Sporting Clay targets and 200 Skeet targets. Our Collegiate Sporting Clay Team of Logan Wilcox, Hunter Brander, and Tyler Moore shot a 506/600 taking 3rd place. Also, our Intermediate Advance Sporting Clay team of Jake Lotterman, Soren Hanson, and Jadon Butler shot a 460/600 giving them a win for 5th place. Our Collegiate Skeet Team of Brett Belrose, Logan Wilcox and Hunter Brander shot a 579/600 which was good enough to be Crowned National Champions. (which is the 3rd year in a row for them). Our Intermediate Advance Skeet Team of Jake Lotterman, Soren Hanson, and Jadon Butler shot a 575/600. That team was also Crowned National Champions. (which was their second year in a row). All of the kids shot great. A lot of good competition out there. We had many kids shoot their personal best with Jacob Hults shooting his 1st registered 50 straight in skeet and Ethan Meyer shooting his first 100 straight in skeet. We as coaches are very proud of all shooters and are very excited for the next season. The kids would also like to thank all the members and club for their support and donations.
