
The club will be closed on Wednesdays now until November.

Meeting Minutes

7:10 pm - Membership meeting

Roger Hill, Gordy Anderson, Sam Yeo were present but had no comments. Membership meeting closed at 7:13 pm.

Roll Call: Present- Steve Rechner, Scott Treichel, Larry Mennetti, Adam Nelson, Mike Daly, Mark Jacobson. Excused – Doug Bacon, Thad Bembenista, Cameron Meyer.

MUCC: Pat Klott was present. She reported on the deer ticks, Rocky mountain fever. Tracks magazine is available for 3 grade on up. You can sponsor a school if anyone is interested. The magazine goes from Oct. thru May. The cost is \$3.75 per kid with 10 or more. The board decided they would be willing to sponsor Good Willy School. Pat will check on how many students in the school. Motion was passed to sponsor Good Willy school – funds up to 75 students at \$3.75 up to \$300. Passed unanimously.

Minutes from previous month approved.

Finance:

Worked out payment plan with IRS to pay FUTA Taxes. We were paying the wrong percentage in the past. Will take a couple of months to get results on penalties.

Motion was made, seconded and voted on to approve hiring Sarah and Norris Accounting as our accounting services. Passed unanimously.

Finance Committee will have 2018 budget ready in October for November Board Meeting.

Presidents/Manager Report: Called and left message for Armen Kassouni to go over his concerns. Outings – gave out a list of outings to all BOD members. June 10th is SCI Membership Appreciation Day. A big Thank You to Joe Pedersen for allowing KCCL to host this event. Open to all members and family. It will be a lot of fun for everyone – Come out it's all free. We have tickets to sell for this day! Over \$40,000 worth of prizes. 3/\$50 or 10/\$100. Anyone would like some tickets let us know.

Membership went down about 20 members. 2 big corporate memberships paid in April last year that were due in May so the numbers were higher than they were supposed to be.

Some ideas that were tossed around about keeping up on our safety around the club. We do have a safety officer up at the rifle range volunteering on Sundays for now.

Everyone needs to watch the safety video before shooting. Need to figure out a way to have all existing members watch the safety videos. New members – we will need to make a video for them to watch. We are trying to do everything we can to continue our safety.
