7 pm: Membership meeting called to order. No members were present. Closed at 7:02.

Steve Rechner – Thanked Sara, Tim, Julie and Adam for all their work on putting the 2018 Budget together. We all spent the last week putting the budget together. Motion was made to discuss the 2018 budget, 2nd and all approved.

Adam – let everyone know that we were able to go off the process we did the prior year, which made this year a lot easier to put together. After, the board went over the budget and had some discussion, Motion was made to adopt the 2018 Budget. 2nd – all in favor – carries unanimously.

Mark made a motion to increase James and Julie's PTO from 2 weeks a year to 3 weeks starting in 2018. Motion was made to accept proposal, 2nd, carries unanimously.

The BOD reviewed the P & L. No questions and the financials were approved.

Mark started discussion on a short-term sick and accident benefit for management. The board wanted Mark to do some research on this and bring back to the January board meeting for more discussion.

New Enhanced CPL

The enhanced CPL class better known as the NRA personal protection outside the home course is an 8-hour class that will be mandated by state law so people can make application to get an enhanced CPL allowing them to travel into many of the currently pistol free zones. Tentatively, February 3rd is our date for the first class. The cost of the class will be \$175. The number of rounds required will be 250 rounds. The personal protection outside the home course is definitely next level stuff that will show you the proper use of holsters drawing from purses briefcases in various other situations involving vehicles and things that are mostly encountered outside the home.
