From the KCCL Rifle Range

As a follow-up to the January newsletter regarding a KCCL Rifle Club we had a meeting on Saturday morning (1/27) over brunch for those that expressed interest by providing me with their email address as requested. All but two were present due to prior commitments. The discussion focused upon common frequent discussions on the range over the past year, and in no particular priority order. What we accomplish will depend upon interest and commitment to participate. There's hopefully something for everyone on the delivery or receiving end of these topics.

On a related topic of range improvements:

We have hooks along the back wall to hang gear bags to help avoid cluttered benches and a bench along the back wall constructed by Wayne Hanshue. We plan on seven more benches as the model bench has been well received as a place for gear as well as seating for observation. I've been accused of napping on it so if you see me doing so give me a kick!

The popular request for better chairs is being addressed. We've considered hydraulic and traditional threaded adjustable. The former will likely fail quickly and the latter difficult to find at an acceptable price. We're trialling fixed-height 18" steel stools (photos) with two securely stacked to 22". Available also is a 24" version that may be appealing for those using a Lead Sled or youngsters that we're happily seeing more of. Please try them out and let us know what you think. If you have other recommendations or sources let us know. We've obtained these for \$60 per pair for comparison.
