Annual Membership Meeting

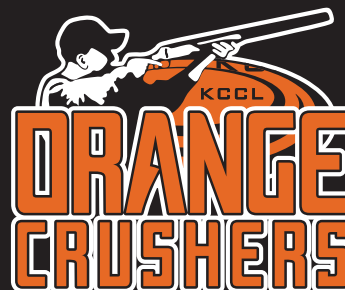
The annual KCCL Membership meeting has been rescheduled for Tuesday, April 21st at 7 PM. The KCCL Board meeting will follow.
