KCCL is open to Members AND Guests starting Tuesday, June 9th!

The Shooters Grill is opening on a limited basis too!

With Father's Day right around the corner, we are thankful for a clear path of reopening and the efforts by MUCC to advocate for this safe process with the state. The soft reopening that started with members only has been smooth and has helped make this next step possible to invite guests again to enjoy KCCL with us. The safety of our families, employees, and visitors remains KCCL's overriding priority throughout this pandemic. KCCL continues to monitor the situation closely and will periodically update club rules with guidance based on current recommendations from the CDC and WHO.

Procedures to Follow

In response to the current pandemic, KCCL has made a lot of changes for your safety and the staff.

Please refer to the following with updates.

1. COVID-19 Questionnaire - We are conducting a simple screening questionnaire of individuals for each visit to KCCL grounds. Your participation is important to help us take precautionary measures to protect you and everyone while at KCCL. No personal information will be requested or collected. **If the answer is "yes" to any of the following questions, please postpone traveling to KCCL.**
 - A. Questionnaire
 - i. Do you have any of the following symptoms?
 - Fever of 100.4 degrees or higher (as measured by a touchless thermometer);
 - Cough (excluding chronic cough due to a known medical reason other than COVID-19);
 - Shortness of breath; or
 - Sore throat.
 - ii. Have you travelled internationally or outside of Michigan in the last 14 days, excluding commuting from a home location outside of Michigan? For purposes of this question, commuting is defined as traveling between one's home and work on a regular basis.
 - iii. Have you had any close contact in the last 14 days with someone with a diagnosis of COVID-19?
 - Any affirmative response to screening questions (A)(i) or (ii) above requires the individual to be excluded:
 - i. For at least 72 hours with no fever (three full days of no fever without use of medicine that reduces fever) and other symptoms have improved (for example, when cough and shortness of breath have improved) and at least seven days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
 - ii. For 14 days following travel unless that travel was due to commuting from a home location outside of Michigan.

2. When visiting KCCL:

- Face coverings are required while inside the buildings. Staff are required to wear masks at all times. Keep in mind that face coverings are required to use the bathrooms and visit the lockers.
- Follow all CDC and WHO guidelines for social distancing, safe handwashing, avoid groups of people, et cetera.
 - i. If any groups are not able to maintain distancing or wear face masks appropriately, staff are required to stop service for staff safety and your range time will be ended.
- Continue to strictly follow safe gun handling rules and Range Safety Officer (RSO) directions.
- KCCL is open for members, guests, and small special events.
- Prepare and make safe guns at your vehicle.
- The front porch is open to access the clubhouse, make payments at the window, and limited dependent on distancing rules.
- The side porch is open for limited use and the fire pit, dependent on distancing rules.
- One-way traffic in and out of the clubhouse has been designated. Please follow posted signs.
- Capacity until further notice:
 - i. Facility capacity is limited to 100 people total for the entire grounds, inclusive of staff.
 - ii. No more than 2 people in restrooms at a time and no more than 40 people in the clubhouse.
 - iii. We have tape on the floors as a guide for distancing.
 - iv. Seating indoors is reduced to suit the allowed capacity.
 - v. Limit your time indoors. Remain outside the clubhouse, unless you need to cool down in the A/C, use the restroom, go to your locker, or similar purposes.
- Sales will be primarily completed through the porch window, including sales of store items, snacks, beverages, and ammunition. The indoor sales counter is open but limited for use.
- Purchases and Tips:
 - i. Credit Card payments only are encouraged. Limit use of cash and checks.
 - ii. Use of "Tap & Pay" function are encouraged where credit limits allow (often a \$50 limit).
 - iii. Purchase of punch cards are also encouraged to limit time paying for shooting activities.
- Shooters' Grill:
 - i. The kitchen is open weekdays 4-8pm and limited on weekends.
 - ii. Grab and go take-out orders are available with a basic menu.
- Shooting Activities:
 - i. You may call for reservations for all shooting areas. Rifle and Pistol Range space is limited.
 - ii. SKEET
 - 5 shooters maximum
 - Puller/RSO remains at rear of field (similar to trap) with shooters
 - 1 shooter per station, all other shooters rotate to remain at rear of field
 - Shooter must pick up own shells before leaving each station
 - Guns should be placed on racks between shooting stations to allow easier RSO oversight of safe handling of guns.
 - All tips electronic only (no cash)
 - iii. TRAP and 5-STAND

- 5 shooters maximum
 - Puller/RSO remains at rear of field
 - 1 shooter per station (no doubles)
 - Shooter must pick up own shells before leaving each station
 - Markers have been placed to guide rotating stations 5-1 and distancing
 - All tips electronic only (no cash)
- iv. PISTOL AND RIFLE RANGES
- Ranges operate at 1/2 capacity (7 shooters per range).
 - If range reaches capacity, range time will be limited to 1 hour.
 - No range access tickets will be exchanged – staff will call RSO shooter clearances.
 - Every other station is closed and marked.
 - Shooters stay on station until cease fire called.
 - a. If any shooter wishes to enter/exit range house, all shooters must exit to allow shooter to circulate to designated lane to maintain distancing.
 - Shooter must pick up own casings and place in designated buckets before leaving each station. Brooms and shovels are limited to staff use only.
 - As a reminder, ranges are designated No Smoking areas for OSHA requirements.
- v. TRAINING RANGE / BUNKER
- Training range is open for limited use dependent upon distancing rules.
- vi. SPORTING CLAYS
- Sporting Clays will be limited to 5 groups / hour. Groups with maximum of 5 shooters.
- vii. ARCHERY
- The 3D Course is open and limited to 5 groups / hour. Groups with maximum of 5 archers.
 - Target Range is open, but limited up to 10 archers dependent on distancing rules.
 - Archers are encouraged to supply their own targets.
- Please do not congregate outside the buildings, in the parking lots, or in high-traffic areas.
 - We encourage you to call ahead prior to arrival to check on availability of shooting fields.

Thank you very much for doing your part to ensure the safety and health of everyone around you. We hope this pandemic clears, these restrictions are short-lived, and we can use our club more as we have been accustomed.

Be safe, enjoy the outdoors, and have fun with the activities at KCCL we all love.
