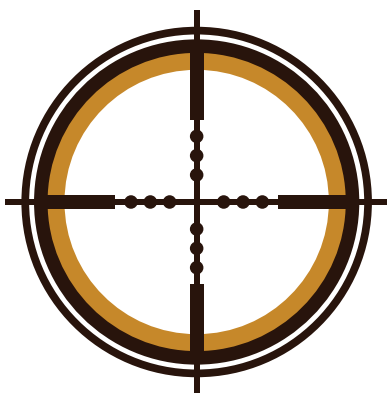

## “Giveaway”

Each event you sign up for gets you a ticket for a drawing of a 40 punch card as well as a Sporting Clays card with 300 targets on it.

Early Shooting begins 12/15/20, while week one officially begins 01/05/2021. Skeet and Trap shooters must have 4 lines in by 01/31/2021 to be classed. After week 4, penalization will begin for skeet and trap shooters who are not current. Skeet and Trap shooters may shoot up to 4 weeks ahead, but will be penalized 1 target for every week they are behind after week 4. Any lines shot after 3/31/21 will not count for the league.

Scores will be posted on the website and will be scrolling on a TV in the clubhouse.
