YOUTH SAFETY REGULATIONS

August 26, 2022

To: KCCL Members

KCCL is proud of its safety record as well as its support for the introduction of young people to all aspects of the shooting sports. The August meeting with our Board of Directors included a review of compliance with federal and state laws governing the use and transportation of firearms and the sale of ammunition.

The conclusions of this review are that:

1. Any person under the age of 18 must be supervised by an adult 18 years of age or older while handling a firearm or on the shooting field(s).

In addition, federal law prohibits the sale of rifle or shotgun ammunition to anyone under the age of 18 and prohibits the sale of handgun ammunition to anyone under the age of 21.

2. Any ammunition sales must comply with these laws, which impact primarily our SCTP children. The parents of children shooting at KCCL will be responsible for buying and supplying the ammunition for their children.

These regulations will be implemented beginning August 31, 2022.

NEW CASH CARD SYSTEM

We have implemented the new Cash Card System at KCCL for Trap, Skeet, and 5-Stand.

You can get your new card at the front counter in the Clubhouse.

Punch cards will no longer work, but every existing punch can be exchanged for an equivalent cash amount. Please bring your punch card(s) to the counter and the existing value will be applied to your new Cash Card!
